People use different key words in an attempt to communicate. But just what does “white”, “natural”, “straight”, “big”, “small” mean to the patient that you are talking with at that particular time?

Do these words have the same meaning from patient to patient, dentist to dentist and dental ceramist to dental ceramist?

Because these are “just” words, the patient may still not fully understand the options or be able to visualize them even with computer imaging. So to let the patient see the potential outcomes 3-dimensionally, diagnostic wax up were done and removable trial smiles were subsequently created from the wax up. Once the patient inserts the Trial Smile she can instantly see the difference.

All clinical procedures need to have communication between the key players that will be used for that particular case. Synergy between all the key players, the periodontist, general dentist, prosthodontist, orthodontist and the ceramist should be a priority for treatment.

restoration. This is extremely important in some cases. The ceramist is able to create the same type of effects into these acrylic materials that they have envisioned to create in the final ceramic restoration. The patient can again actually feel and also function with the provisional in place and evaluate the esthetic changes. They can at this provisional stage find their likes and dislikes and make changes in the acrylic instead of in the final restoration where changes are sometimes difficult to make. It is essential to realize the exact special effects and characterizations and where they are in the natural teeth prior to internally placing them in the ceramic restoration to get a



lifelike result. Getting rid of internal characterizations that are unwanted by the patient or placed in the wrong position becomes a very frustrating journey to an unknown outcome.

In summary let me say what many people have heard me often say: "No man is an island." We all need each other to pull off the ultimate in dentistry. No aspect of dentistry can survive this "esthetic" rush if we think we can do it on our own. We must learn to communicate better and most of all to respect the profession on our colleagues.



This will integrate communication that will ultimately lead to success.

Once the patient decides to go ahead with treatment after the "**Trial Smile**" then the next ultimate diagnostic tool is the provisional
