Type of Film: This is La Right ^{Distal} Molar Biting.

Errors → Cone Cut, Film not parallel with the plane of occlusion.
Film not capturing the alveolar bone in maxillary teeth.

- TOOTH # 2 → occlusal amalgam
- # 3 → Severe Recurrent caries under M.O. amalgam + OL
- # 4 → Severe Recurrent caries ^M under D.O. amalgam (mesial aspect of tooth)
- # 29 → Missing tooth
- # 30 → M.O. amalgam, Advanced interproximal caries on Distal
- # 31 → Moderate interproximal caries on Mesial, advanced ^{Mod} occlusal caries
