- ✓ b. Severe Pericoronitis

10 2. List 3 indications for surgical extractions

- ✓ a. Very dense buccal Bone
- ✓ b. Divergent Root form
- ✓ c. Root Apex Near Maxillary Sinus

10 3 List 3 conditions that must exist for a tooth root to be left in the alveolar process

- ✓ a. No caries in Root or periapical Radiolucency.
- ✓ b. Must be less than 4mm long.
